An unpaid carer is someone, of any age, who provides **unpaid support** to family or friends who **could not manage without this help**. This could be caring for a relative, partner or friend who is ill, frail, disabled or has mental health or substance misuse problems.

If you or the person you are looking after is going into hospital or is already in hospital, we have dedicated Carer Officers in each hospital who can provide information on your rights as an unpaid Carer and access to other support including community services.
